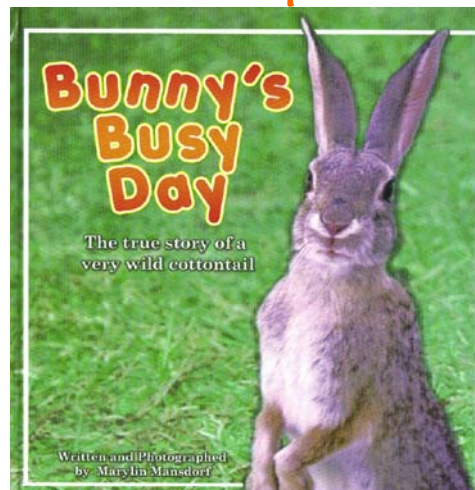

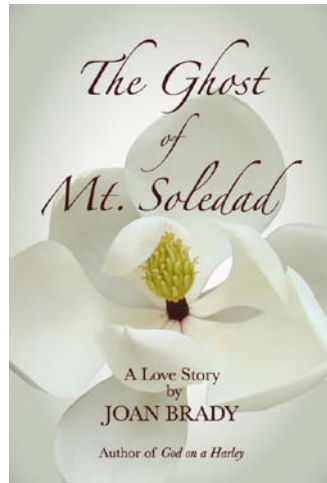


BUNNY'S BUSY DAY

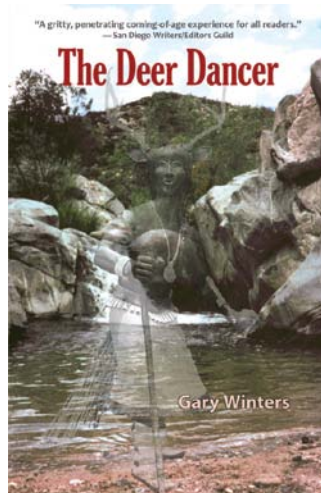


THE GHOST OF MT. SOLEDAD

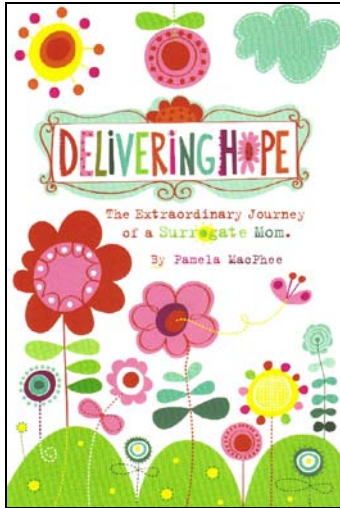


THE DEER DANCER

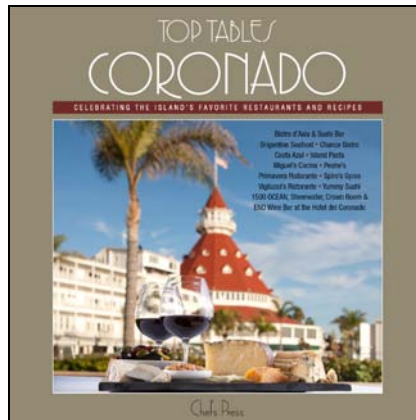

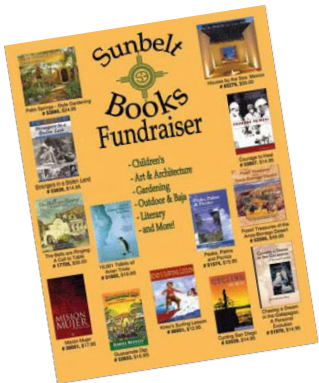
